# 2. FOR WHICH PURPOSES DO WE PROCESS YOUR DATA AND UNDER WHICH AUTHORITY?

The information you provide us through the website may vary depending on the services you request from us or the actions you have expressly allowed us. In general, we may treat your data for the following purposes:

## 3. WHAT CATEGORIES OF DATA AND TREAT where we get that data?

The personal data that will treat are your identifying information you provide directly, either through the registration form you will find on our website or through other means, for example, inquiries or complaints planted the service to the client. Particularly, personal data that are treated include the following categories:

- -Data identification: name, address, telephone, email, date of birth, age and sex.
- -Data economic: bank details of returned items.
- -Location: if you use functions based on location and have enabled location services in the settings of your computer or mobile, its geographical location in real time and IP address as well as the locations of the access point Wi -fi group and telephony relay antennas. In any case, the Company is not responsible for the use of false, inaccurate, incomplete data, date not provided by the Customer.

## 4. WHO ARE RECIPIENTS OF YOUR DATA AND HOW THE STORE?

- 4.1. Recipients: the data you provide will not be transferred to third parties except to Public Administrations, Judges, Courts, Security Forces where there is a legal obligation to provide.
- 4.2. Managers of treatment: to perform certain functions necessary for the provision of the service by the Company, as fraud and default prevention management, its data can be

processed by third parties as MAP PAYMENTS SERVICES SL to act as responsible for treatment and are contractually obliged to comply with their legal obligations in charge of treatment to maintain confidentiality and secrecy of information.

4.3. #### 5. HOW LONG we keep your data?

The data provided will be retained as long as the contractual relationship with the customer is maintained or its status as a registered user or the time required to meet the relevant purpose, if any remain.

When your data is no longer necessary for the purpose for which they were obtained, will be blocked and will to currently available only at the request of judges and courts, the prosecutor or the competent public authorities the years necessary to meet legal obligations and, after this term will be completely eliminated.

## 6. WHAT ARE YOUR RIGHTS AND HOW CAN exercise them?

- 6.1. Rights. Our data protection legislation confers a number of rights in relation to data processing involving our services can be summarized as follows:
  - Access Rights: know what kind of data you're trying on.
  - Right of rectification: to request amendment of your data because these are inaccurate or untruthful.
  - Right of withdrawal: request the deletion of their data when treatment is no longer necessary.

  - Right Portability: Allows the applicant to receive your personal data in a structured format, commonly used and machine readable to move, copy or transfer to another responsible.

- 6.3. Right not to be subject to a decision based solely on automated processing of data.
